Court safety

Members are advised to wear appropriate clothing, in particular appropriate footwear.

Please note the courts may become slippery following inclement weather, especially frost. The areas around the lines and edges of the court may be slow to dry out.

All users should be aware of the activity of other users and be safe and courteous with regard to other players.

Children should be supervised at all times to ensure that their behaviour is not a risk to themselves or others.

Accident or emergency

There is no public telephone on the premises. Members should have access to a mobile phone or be aware of places where they may be able to seek assistance, eg from others on court, from the club house if occupied, or the Grand Union pub between Camberwell Grove and Grove Lane. If directing the emergency services, the entrance to the courts is opposite 52 Grove Lane, Camberwell London SE5 8ST.

It is the individual responsibility of members to inform those they are playing of any relevant health issues, and of parents to ensure that any persons supervising children are aware of any such issues in relation to the child.

Please inform the Club of any accident or health issue occurring on the premises as soon as is reasonable and possible.
